	12:8-9	From there he went on toward the hills east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east. There he built an altar to the LORD and called on the name of the LORD. ⁹ Then Abram set out and continued toward the Negev	√	√	
	12:10-20	Abram goes to Egypt and tells pharaoh that Sarai is his sister. GOD inflicts disease on pharaoh, so pharaoh sends Abram away.			D
	13:1-3	Abram went up from Egypt to the Negev...From the Negev he went from place to place until he came to Bethel, to the place between Bethel and Ai where his tent had been earlier and where he had first built an altar. There Abram called on the name of the LORD.	√		
	13:5-18	Abram and Lot separate, with Lot going into the plain of the Jordan. The Lord speaks to Abram after Lot leaves and promises him the land as far as he can see to his offspring. Then Abram went to live near the great trees of Mamre at Hebron, where he built an altar to the LORD		√	S,P
	14:14-15	Abram learns that kings Amraphel, Arioch, Kedorlaomer, & Tidal have captured Lot and the people of Sodom, so he goes as far as Dan that night. Then pursued them as far as Hobah, north of Damascus where he recovers Lot and the people of Sodom.			
	14:17-20	In the valley of Shaveh (that is, the King's Valley) Melchizedek king of Salem blesses Abram and he gives the king a 10 th of everything.			
	15:1-18	GOD first appears to Abram in a vision then speaks to him telling of how the promises will be fulfilled.			S,P

	18:1-33	The LORD appeared to Abraham near the great trees of Mamre... Then the LORD said, "I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah your wife will have a son. The LORD tells Abraham of what He is going to do to Sodom & Gamorah. Abraham pleas for the righteous (Lot & family). The next morning Abraham views the destruction from where he			A,S
	20:1-17	Now Abraham moved on from there into the region of the Negev and lived between Kadesh and Shur . For a while he stayed in Gerar . Abraham tells king Abimelech that Sarah is his sister and the king takes her but doesn't lie with her. God came to Abimelech in a dream and Abimelech gives Sarah and much cattle to Abraham who prays for Abimelech.			C,H
100	21:1-7	Sarah became pregnant and bore a son to Abraham in his old age, at the very time God had promised him. They named him Issac			
	21:8-20	Sarah has Abraham send Hagar & Ishmael away. God speaks to Abraham and tells him to do what Sarah asks and he will make Ishmael a nation as well. This was during a feast celebrating Issac being weaned.			S
	21:22-32	Abimelech comes to Abraham and asks for a treaty between them and Abraham agrees. The place is called Beersheba . Abraham planted a tamarisk tree in Beersheba , and there he called upon the name of the LORD, the Eternal God. ³⁴ And Abraham stayed in the land of the Philistines for a long time.	√

	22:1-19	God tests Abraham by telling him to go to Moriah and offer Issac as a sacrifice. An Angel of the Lord speaks to Abraham and tells him that the Lord will make his offspring plentiful and all nations will be blessed because he obeyed God.		√	S,P
137 —	23:1-20	Sarah lived to be a hundred and twenty-seven years old. ² She died at Kiriath Arba (that is, Hebron) in the land of Canaan . So Abraham buys a field and cave in Machpelah near Mamre from the Hittites.			
	24:1-60	Abraham was now old and well advanced in years and sends his servant to get a wife for Issac from his relatives in the land he left. The servant goes and prays that the God of Abraham helps him find the wife. God answers the prayer by bringing Rachael to the well.			
140 —	24:61-66	When the servant arrives with Rachael, Isaac had come from Beer Lahai Roi , for he was living in the Negev and met Rachael and took her as his wife. (Gen 25:20 Isaac was forty years old when he married Rebekah)			
	25:1-6	Abraham took another wife, whose name was Keturah and she bore him six sons. Abraham sent them away before he died to the east.			
175 —	25:7-10	Abraham dies at the age of 175 and is buried with Sarah in the cave in Machpelah near Mamre
