_{A5} Jubal was the father of all who played the harp and flute (Gen 4:21).

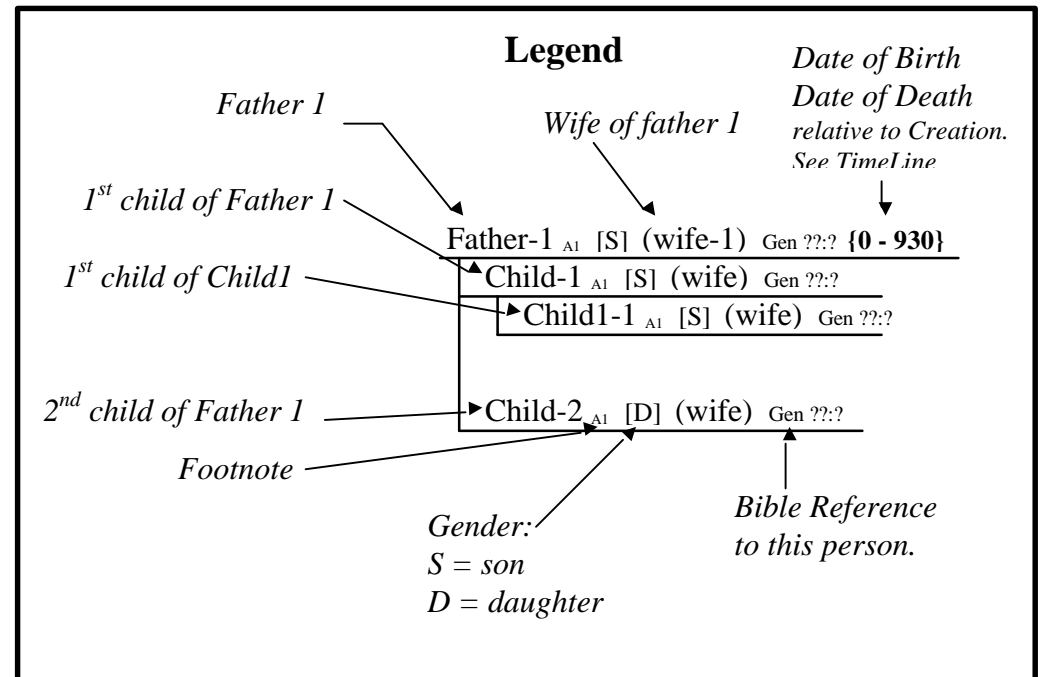
_{A6} Tubal-Cain forged all kinds of tools from bronze and iron (Gen 4:22).

_{A7} Abel tended flocks and offered fat portions from his flock to GOD (Gen 4:4).

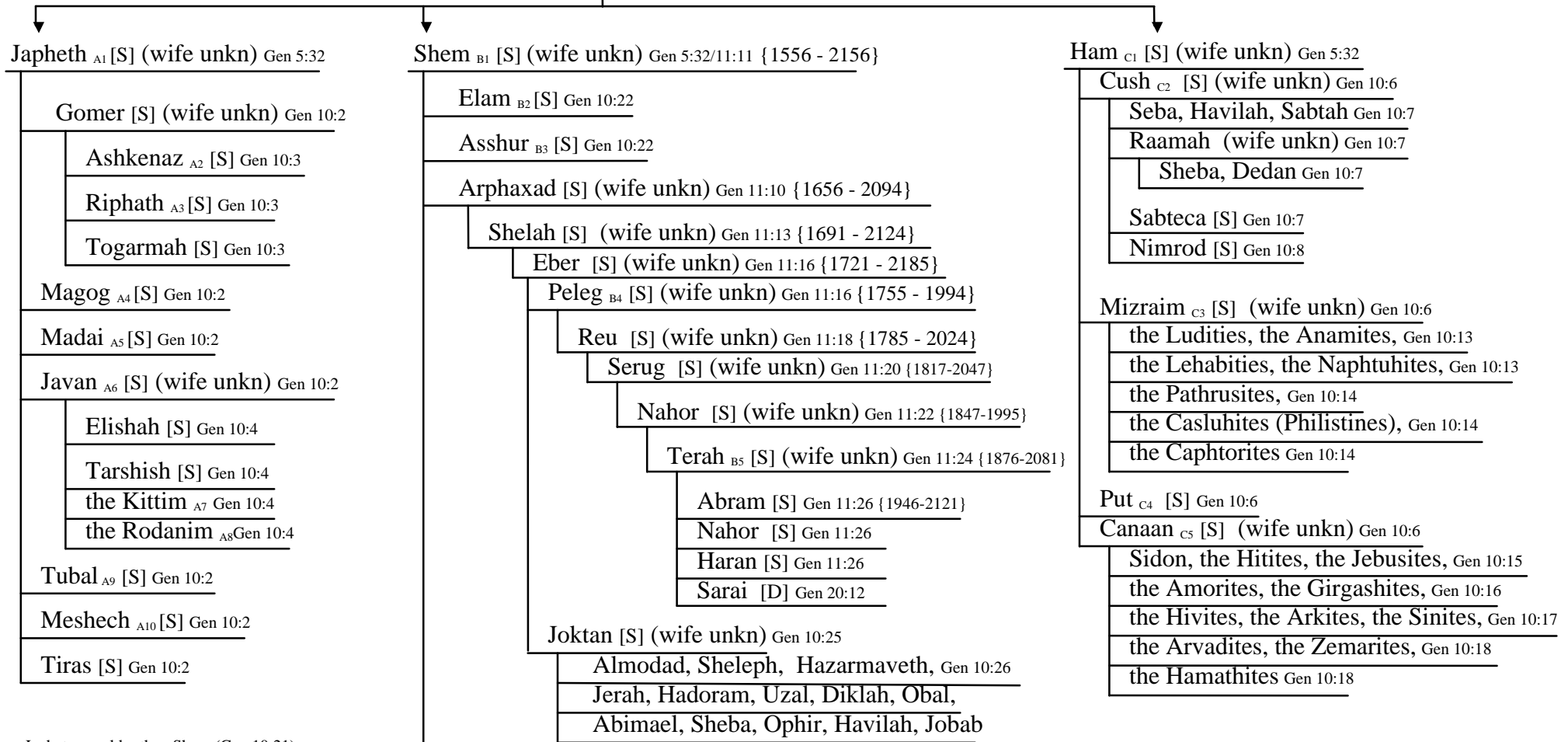
_{A8} Enoch walked with GOD and was no more (Gen 5:24). He did not die, but was translated (Heb 11:5).

_{A9} Methuselah was the oldest recorded man, he was 969 years old when he died (Gen 5:27). He died the year of the flood.

_{A10} Noah, his wife, his sons and their wives are all that survived the flood.

A1 Japhet was older than Shem (Gen 10:21).

A2 Ashkenaz became the name of people who settled in Armenia (I Chr 1:6, Jer 51:27).

A3 Riphath also known as Diphath (I Chr 4:20).

A4 Magog means land of Gog. They are thought to have lived in northern Asia and Europe.

A5 Possible ancestor of the Medes.

A6 Thought to be the father of the Ionians (Greeks).

A7 Kittim, a Hebrew name for part or all of Cyprus.

A8 The Rodanim were probably the inhabitants of the island of Rhodes.

A9 A people who lived in the area of modern Turkey.

A10 Meshech's descendants were known as Moshi (Ez 27:13).

B1 Shem was blessed (Gen 9:26).

B2 Father of the Elamites (Ezr 4:9).

B3 Regarded as ancestor of Assyrians.

B4 His name means 'division'.

B5 See page 3 for his tree.

B6 Ancestor of the Ludim (I Chr 1:11).

B7 Ancestor of Arameans.

C1 Ham looked upon his father's nakedness and his son Canaan was cursed by Noah (Gen 9:25). It is possible that Ham slept with his mother, since in Lev 18:7 KJV uses the same terms for what Ham did.

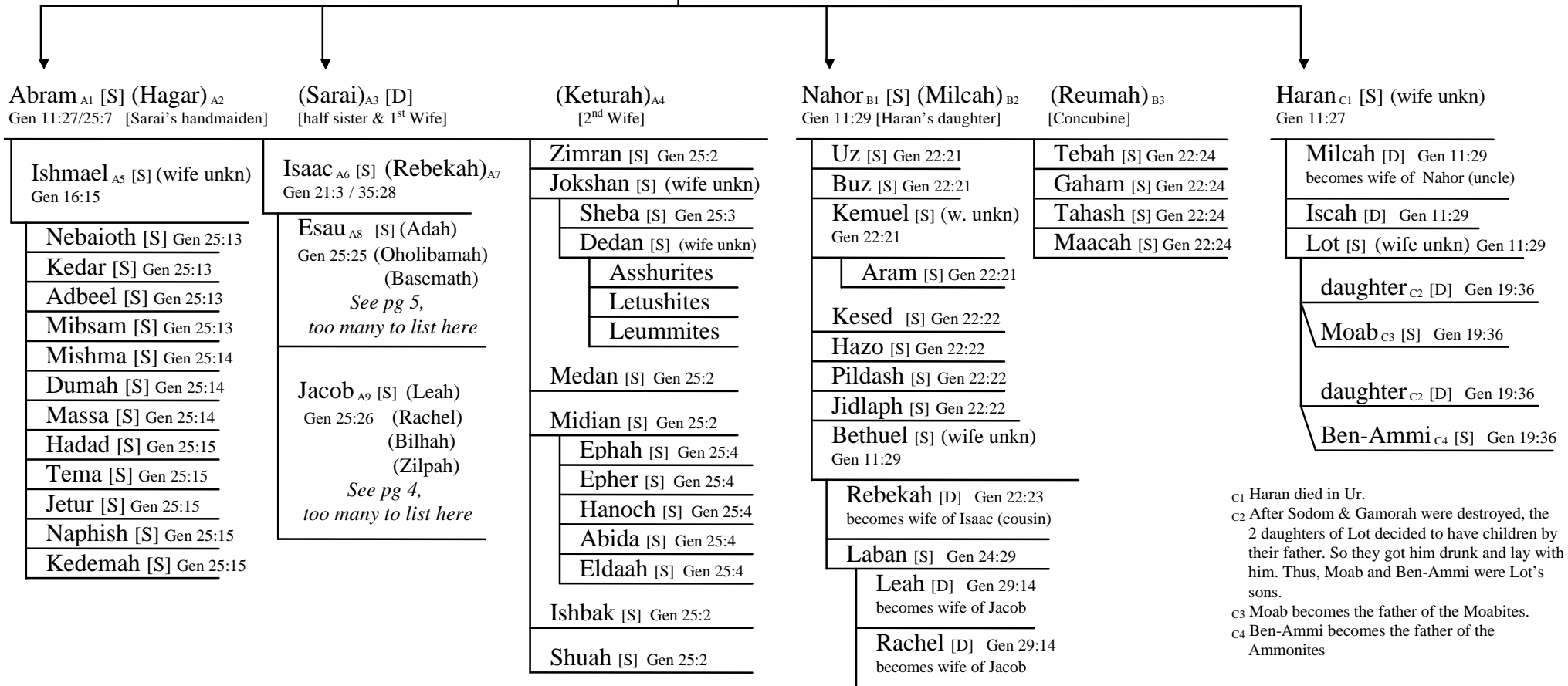
C2 A land south of Egypt, possibly where his descendants lived.

C3 Probably the ancestor of the Egyptians. Egypt is referred to as Mizraim (Gen 50:11).

C4 Spelled 'Phut' in the KJV. Scholars believe this may be related to the people of the region called Put (Ezek 27:10).

C5 Canaan was cursed by Noah for what his father (Ham) did to Noah. GOD promised Abram the land of Canaan.

^{A1} Abram was later named by GOD to Abraham.

^{A2} Hagar was Sarai's Egyptian handmaiden. Sarai gave Hagar to Abram for children. Twelve rulers came from Ishmael as promised by GOD in Gen 17:20.

^{A3} Sarai was later named by GOD to Sarah. She was Abram's half sister Gen 20:12

^{A4} Keturah was Abraham's 2nd wife Gen 25:1

^{A5} Ishmael was bore by Hagar when Abram was 86 (Gen 16:16)

^{A6} Isaac was bore by Sarai when she was 90 (Gen 17:17)

^{A7} Rebekah was Abram's brother's granddaughter.

^{A8} Esau was first born of the twins. He was later called Edom.

^{A9} Jacob was 2nd born of the twins. GOD later named him Israel.

^{B1} Nahor married his niece.

^{B2} Milcah was Nahor's niece.

^{B3} Reumah was Nahor's concubine Gen 22:24
